

Getting around

Please note that throughout the duration of the conference the Botley Road will be closed to all vehicles. Pedestrian and cycle access will be possible at all times. This means that anyone travelling from the railway station West toward Botley and Cumnor will have to connect by foot to the West side of the railway line where they will be able to get a bus (including the Park and Ride). Traveling into the city from Botley Road, Botley or Cumnor direction they will have to get off the bus before the railway line, connect by foot and will be able to access buses on the Eastern side. The routes between the railway station and the city will not be affected.
